1ST TERM

FALL

SHZ103 Introduction to Social Work (3+0)3 ECTS: 5

This course is considered as an introduction to basic concepts of social work. After the introduction to the concept of social welfare course and scope of the definition of social science and social work as a discipline, social service, professional qualifications, the goals, functions and distinctive features are the main topics.

SHZ101 Introduction to Sociology (2+0)2 ECTS: 4

The aim of Introduction to Sociology, students, social interaction, social communication, social change and the change process, social structure, social practice, such as the social environment and social institutions to explain the concepts in detail.

PSG103 Introduction to Psychology (2+0)2 ECTS: 5

SPRING

SHZ102 Disabled Rights and Social Work

(2+0) 2 ECTS: 4

SHZ216 Social Service Institutions

(2+2)3 ECTS: 6

This course provides students introductory knowledge about social work and social services. Students visit different social service agencies i.e. squatter housing and villages to obtain information. Every week each student writes a report on the week's subject.

SHZ106 Social Problems

(3+0)3 ECTS:5

This course will focus on examining contemporary national and international problems of inequality related to wealth, the family, disease, and violence. This class will examine social problems from a structural perspective; that is, we will primarily focus on the impact of largescale social forces and their effects on the prosperity of both regions and individuals. We will also consider historical shifts in inequality as a way of framing how we think about social problems and their emergence in the collective conscious.

SHZ203 Social Work Practices-I

Subjects are asked to obtain information. How to practice interoperability earned theoretical understanding of the infrastructure provided. End of the internship the students are asked to write a report on the institution, the report will be discussed and students in classrooms and the depth of training they try to give the social problems faced by the institution.

SHZ235 Introducton to Anthropology
