Topics of Interest

Clinical Psychology: Focuses on the possible causes, diagnosis and treatment of psychopathology, abnormalities and dysfunctional thoughts and behaviors.

Developmental Psychology: Examines the individual from the biological, psychological and social perspectives throughout the developmental process from fertilization to death.

Cognitive Psychology: Examines the mental processes such as perception, attention, memory, and decision making.

Industrial and Organizational Psychology: Examines the efficiency of organizations including management and motivation in the business world.

Social Psychology: Examines the effects of social structures on behavior by evaluating individual behaviours within the social context.

Learning Psychology: Investigates the basic mechanisms of the learning processes within the stimulus-response relationship.

Psychologists graduating from the undergraduate program, based on their level of education and specialization can work in areas such as health facilities, schools, rehabilitation centers, research centers, advertising agencies, public relations and human resources departments of companies, training units of banks and various institutions, research and development departments of institutions, associations, psychological counseling centers, preschool education institutions, department of corrections, nursing homes, psychotechnical assessment centers.
