Objective

Due to the Türkiye's risky location for natural disasters, there is a need for well-trained human labor who will take initiatives in a case of disaster. A disaster is a phenomenon that occurs unexpectedly and affect the socio-cultural life of the society. The objective of this program is to raise competent in their profession and skills, innovative, researcher and initiates that who can provide risk management (prior to the disaster), education, awareness, preparation such as project development and measurement methods to decrease the loss; in the case of crisis management (post-disaster) carrying out all sorts of invention and improvement activities especially including coordination.

Goal

This program aims to provide students with an understanding of emergency and disaster management, as well as to advance their problem-solving and communication skills and to help them improve themselves on topics including fire safety, evacuation, pre-disaster planning and legal bases. Students who completed this program successfully are entitled to receive an associate

degree in Emergency and Disaster Management. Graduates of this program receive the title of Emergency and Disaster Management Technician. In disasters and emergencies, they take part in search and rescue activities as emergency and disaster management technicians, and in making transfers when necessary. They will be able to periodically train everyone in search and rescue and survival. Thus, it will enable institutions and individuals to be able to proactively prepare against hazards, disasters and natural damages. Graduates of the Emergency and Disaster Management program have a great role to play in raising public awareness on pre-disaster – during disaster – post-disaster and education in line with the competencies they have gained.

Those who graduated from Emergency and Disaster Program can do vertical transfer to Emergency and Disaster Management, Nursing, Health Management, and Social Work undergraduate programs with DGS exam.
