EBR111 DEVELOPMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY THEORY 2 APPLICATION 0 CREDIT 2 ECTS 4

Pyramidal and extra-pyramidal system, Cerebeller system, Neuromuscular junction, Cerebro Vascular system diseases; Extra-pyramidal system diseases (migraine, epilepsy), Peripheral nerve diseases, Neurological examination and autonomic nervous system.
